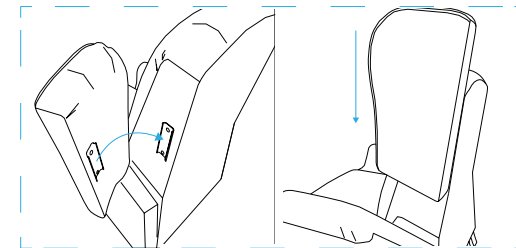

The center console backrest is also stored under the seat base, retrieve this and set it aside.



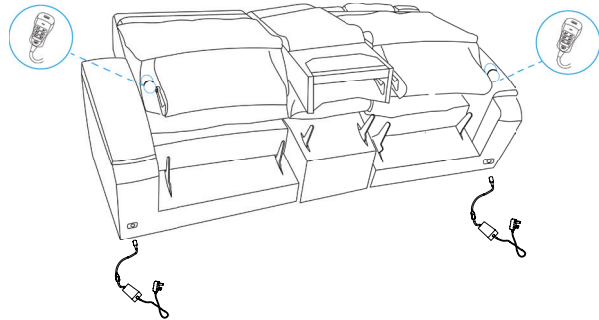

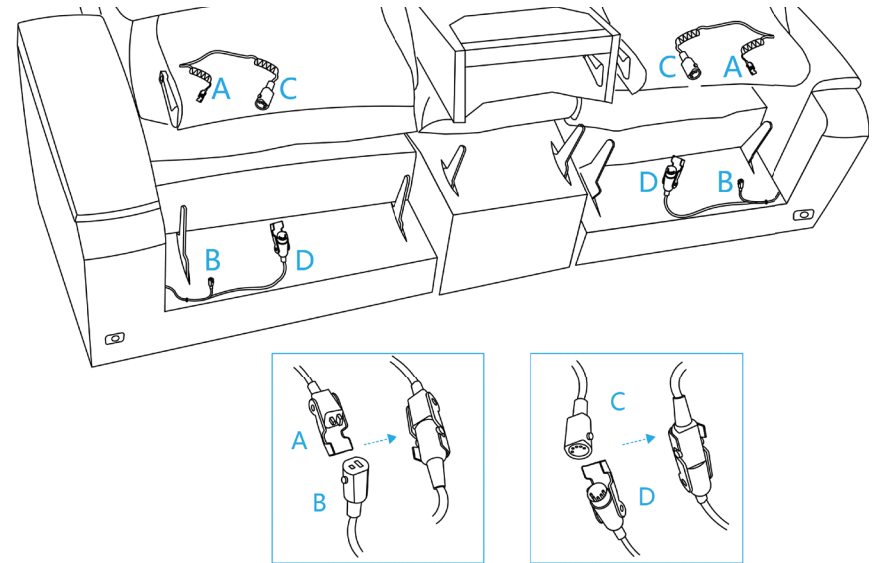

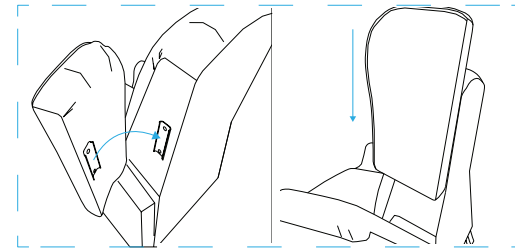

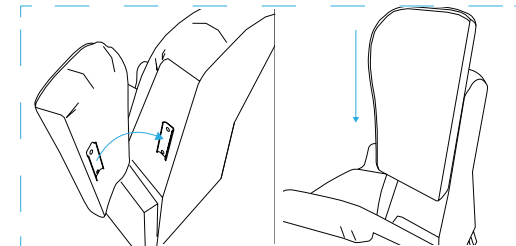

5V / 2A USB Port

Used for charging mobile phones

Lumbar buttons

Used to adjust the position of the lumbar area

Air Massage button

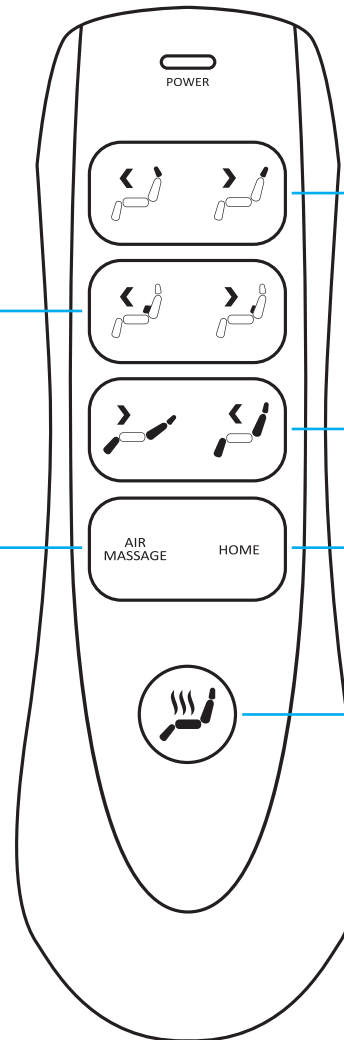
Used to cycle through backrest massage modes:

Press once:	Mode 1	(alternating massage)
Press twice:	Mode 2	(pulsing massage)
Press three times:	Mode 3	(wave massage)
Press four times:	Massage off	

Auto shutdown after 30 minutes.

Allow 10 minutes between massage cycles.

Note: Lumbar and Air Massage functionality can't be used at the same time as they utilise the same air bags



Headrest buttons

Used to adjust the angle of the headrest

Recline buttons

Used to adjust the backrest and foot rest recline.

Home button

Hold to return chair to default upright position. When massage is active, home button will return only the headrest and recliner to the default position.

Heat button

Used to turn backrest heating on or off.

Auto shutdown after 30 minutes.

Allow 10 minutes between heat cycles.
